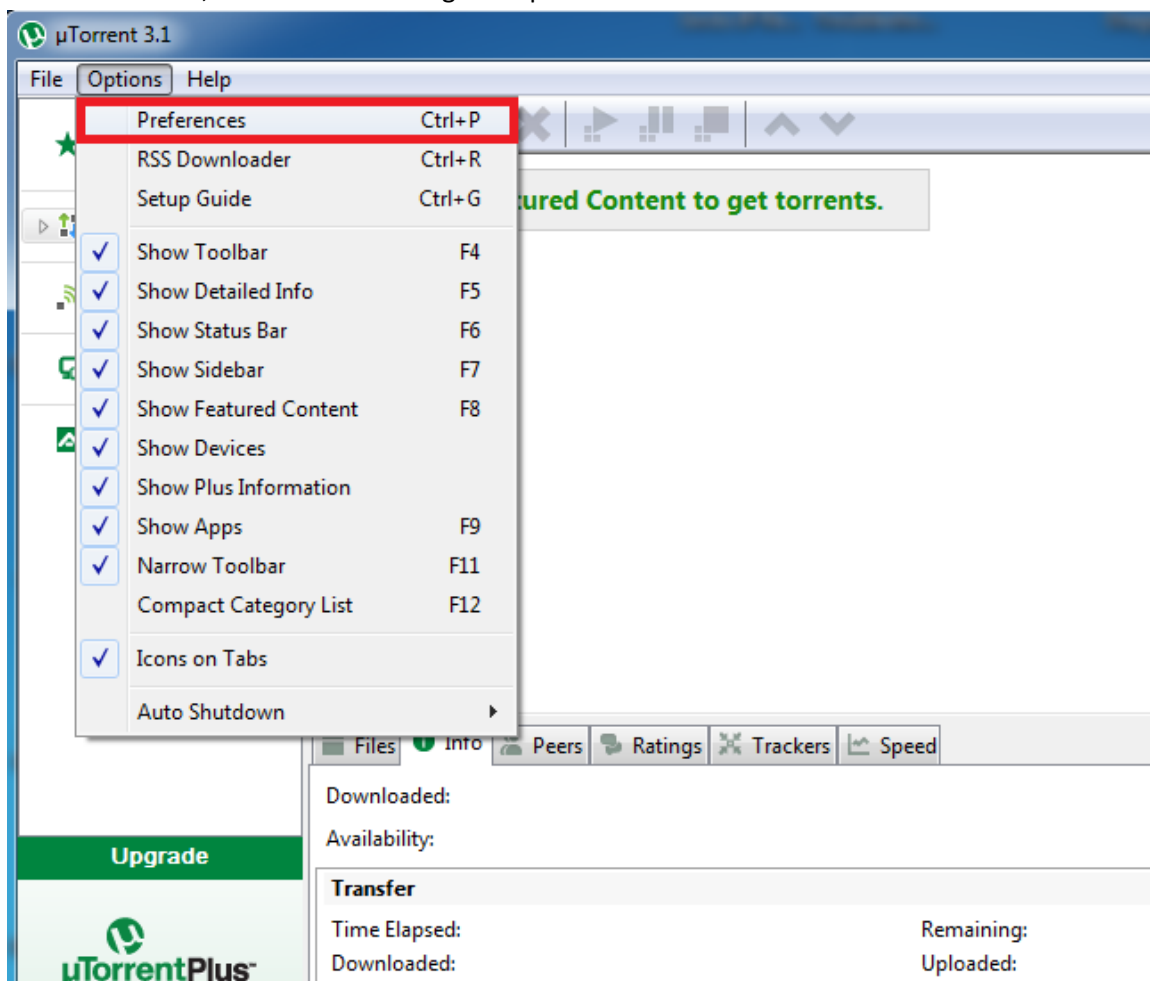


How to Configure uTorrent to Use Authenticated Socks 5 Proxy

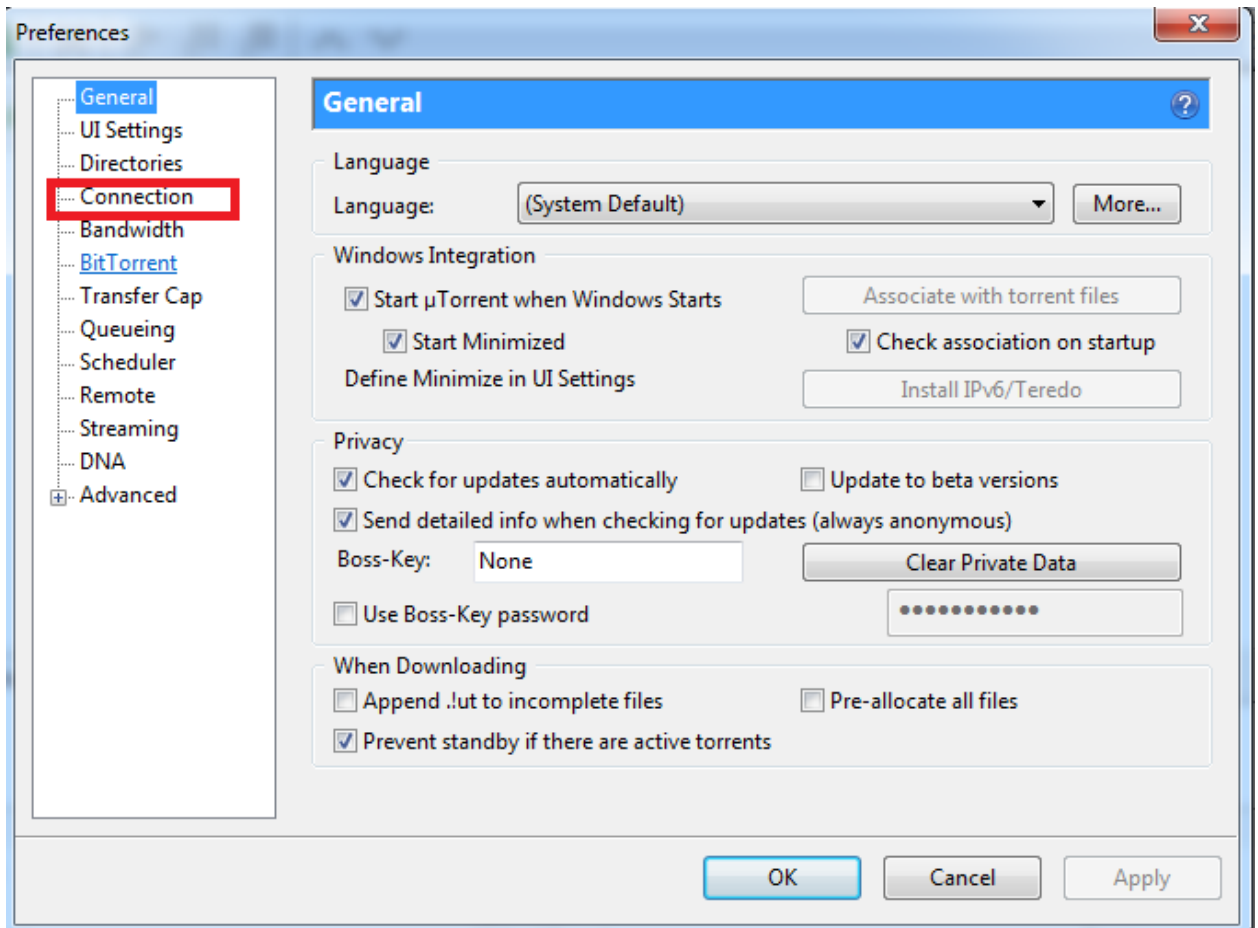
Sock 5 Proxies provides a convenient way to anonymize your IP when using Bittorrent clients such as uTorrent , Vuze, Transmission etc. In addition to the anonymity benefits offered by Socks proxy, Bittorrent over Socks 5 proxy tends to be much faster than using OpenVPN or SSH Tunneling due to the lack of encryption.

The following steps illustrates how to configure uTorrent to use authenticated Socks 5 proxies :

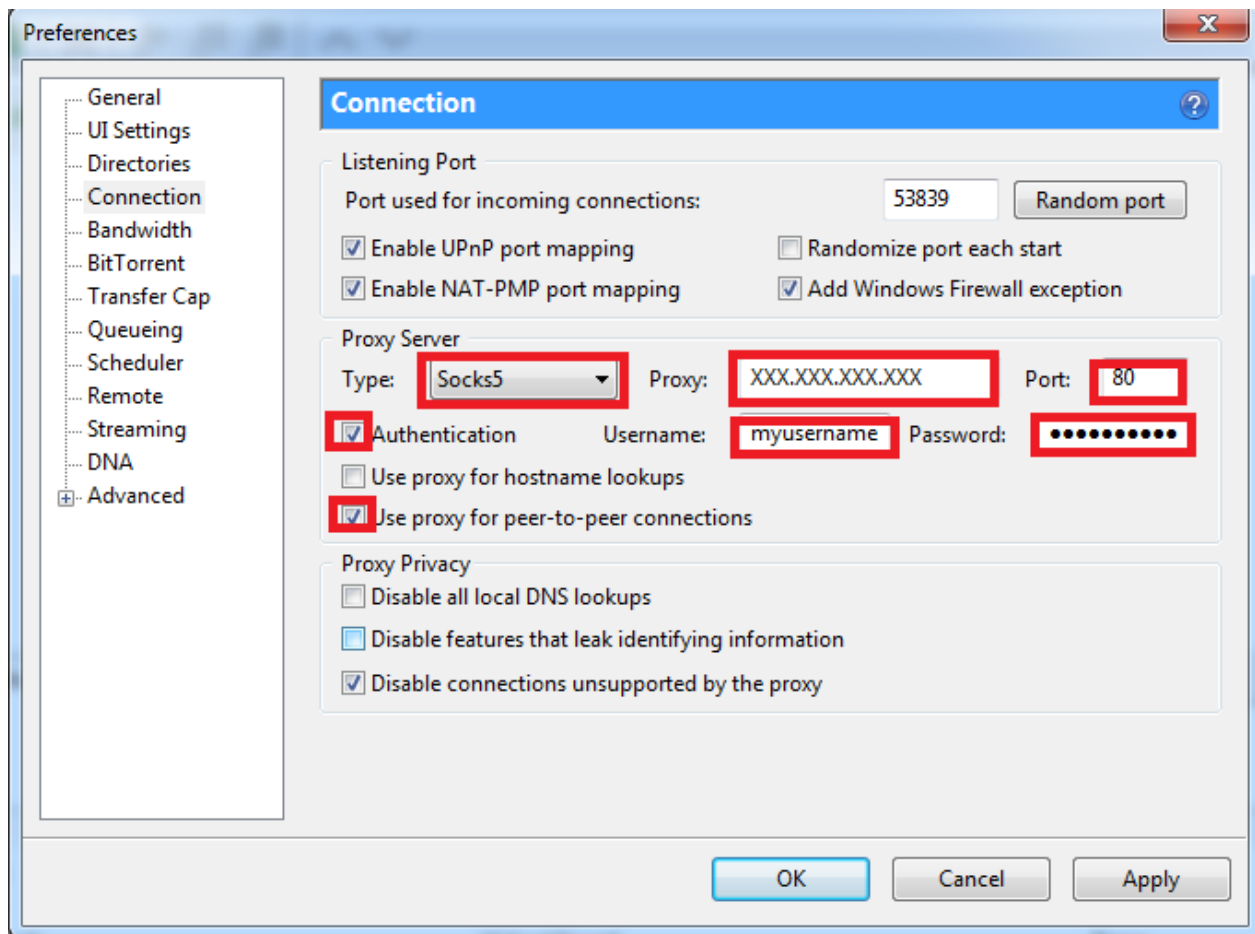
1. Download and Install uTorrent from uTorrent website:

2. After installation, start uTorrent and go to Options>>>Preferences



3. Then click on "Connections"



4. In the Connections window, under the Proxy Server section, select the proxy type as “Socks 5” and enter the Proxy IP and port. Then tick the “ Authentication”tab and enter your member username and password and finally tick the “Use proxy for peer-to-peer connections”. Then click on Apply then OK to save the settings.



5. Begin your torrent activity.
