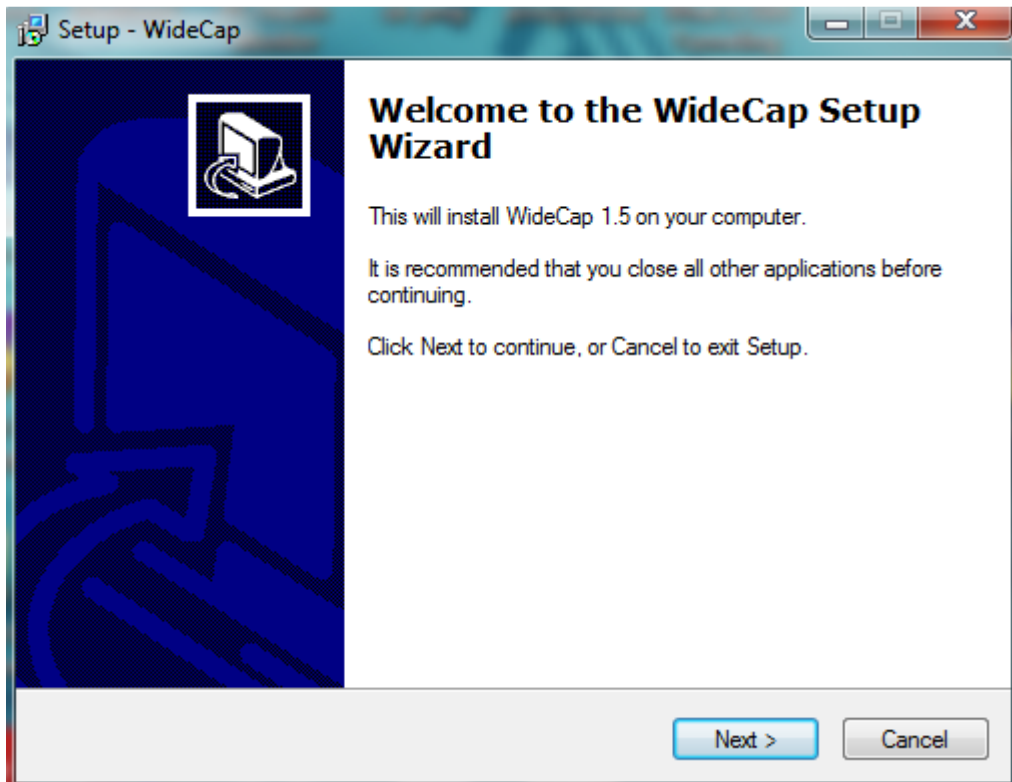


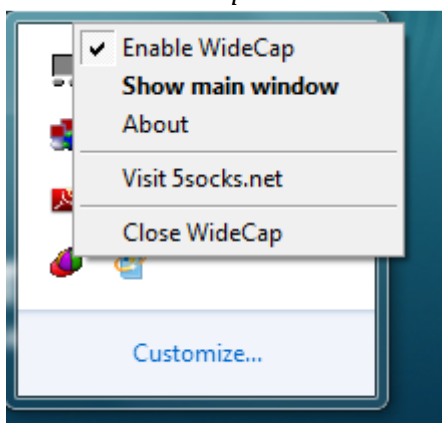
## How to configure Socks 5 Proxy using WideCap Socks Client (Win XP/7)

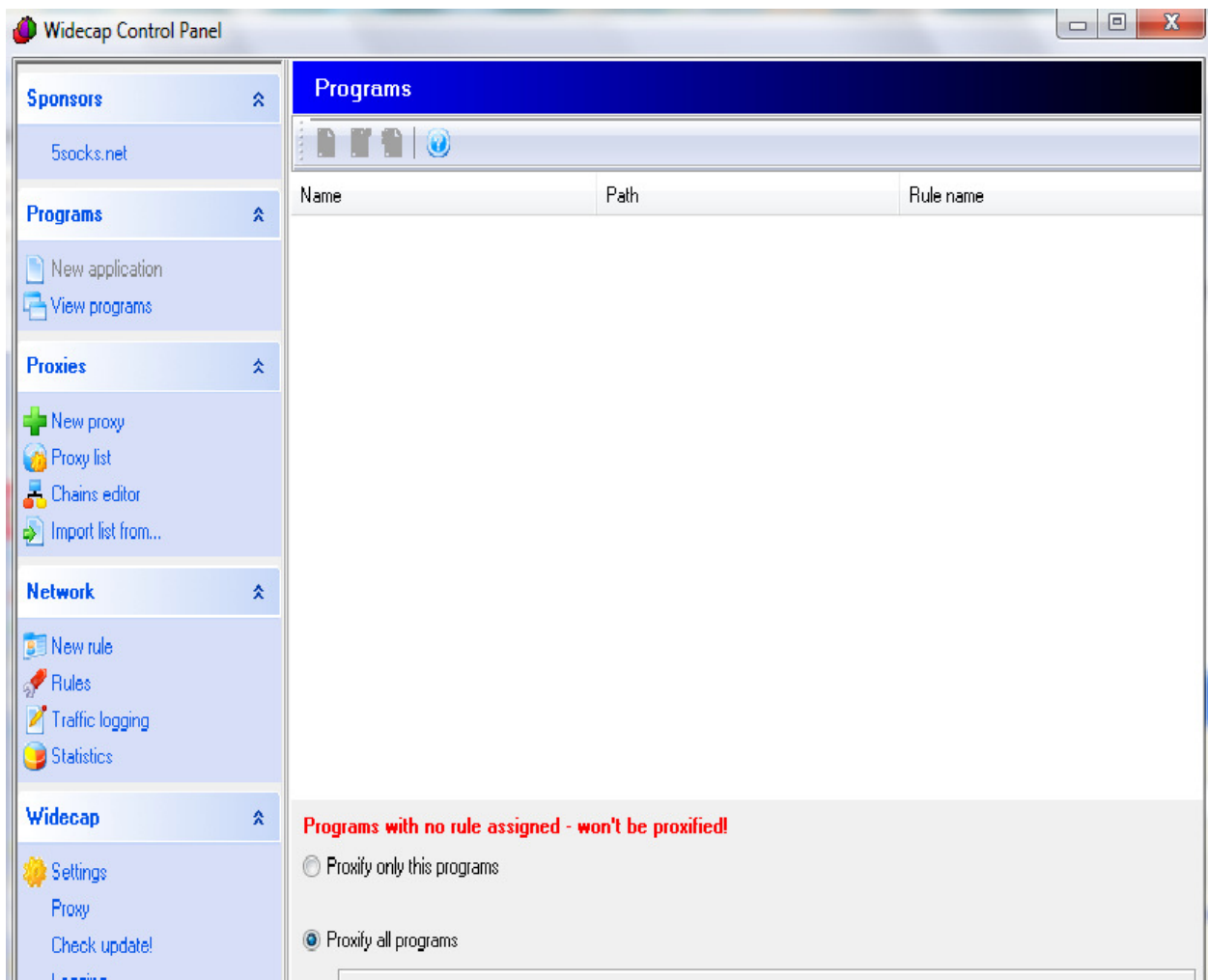
The following instructions can be used to install/configure the WideCap Socks client:

1. Download WideCap client software (FREE) from their site and then install it in your PC. You can also download it directly from our server at: <http://www.bpsocks.com/widecap.exe>



2. Right-click the mouse on WideCap icon in Windows Taskbar to open Widecap menu. Then click on "Enable Widecap" to enable it. Then click on "Show main window" to open the program.

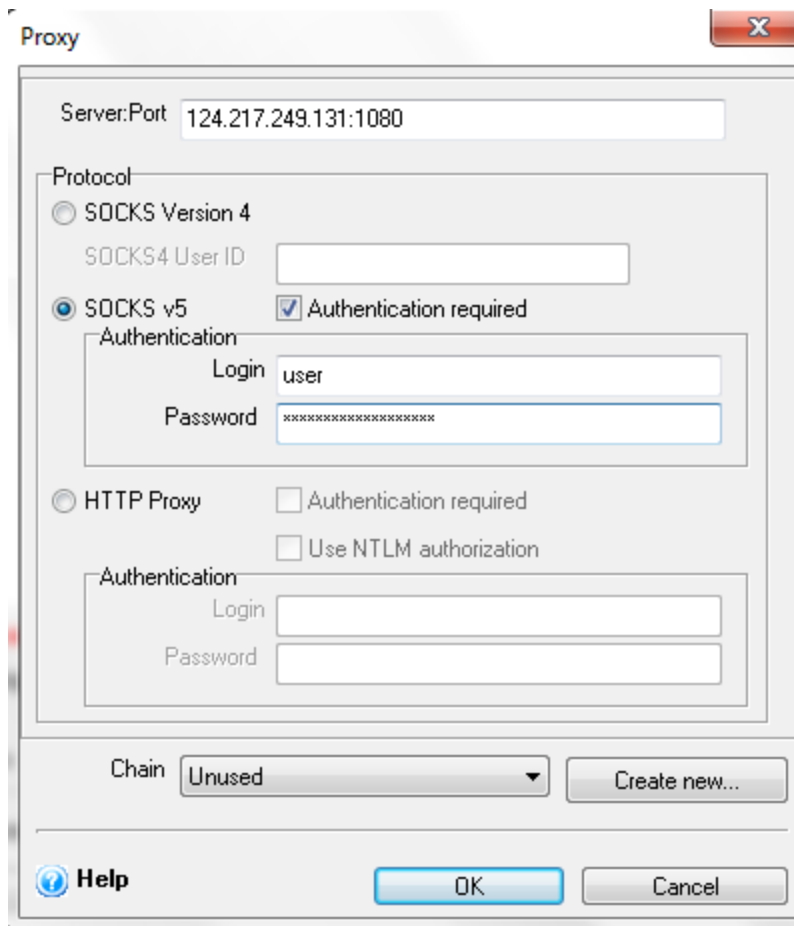




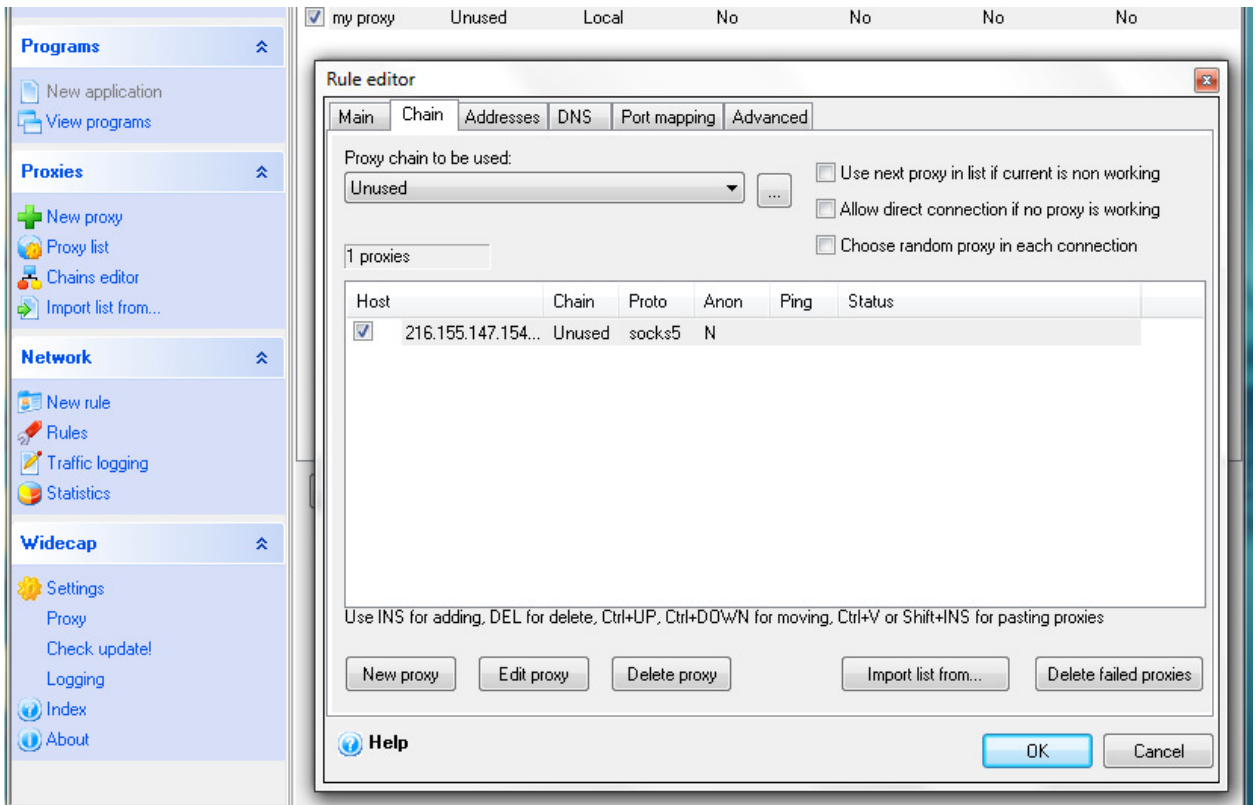
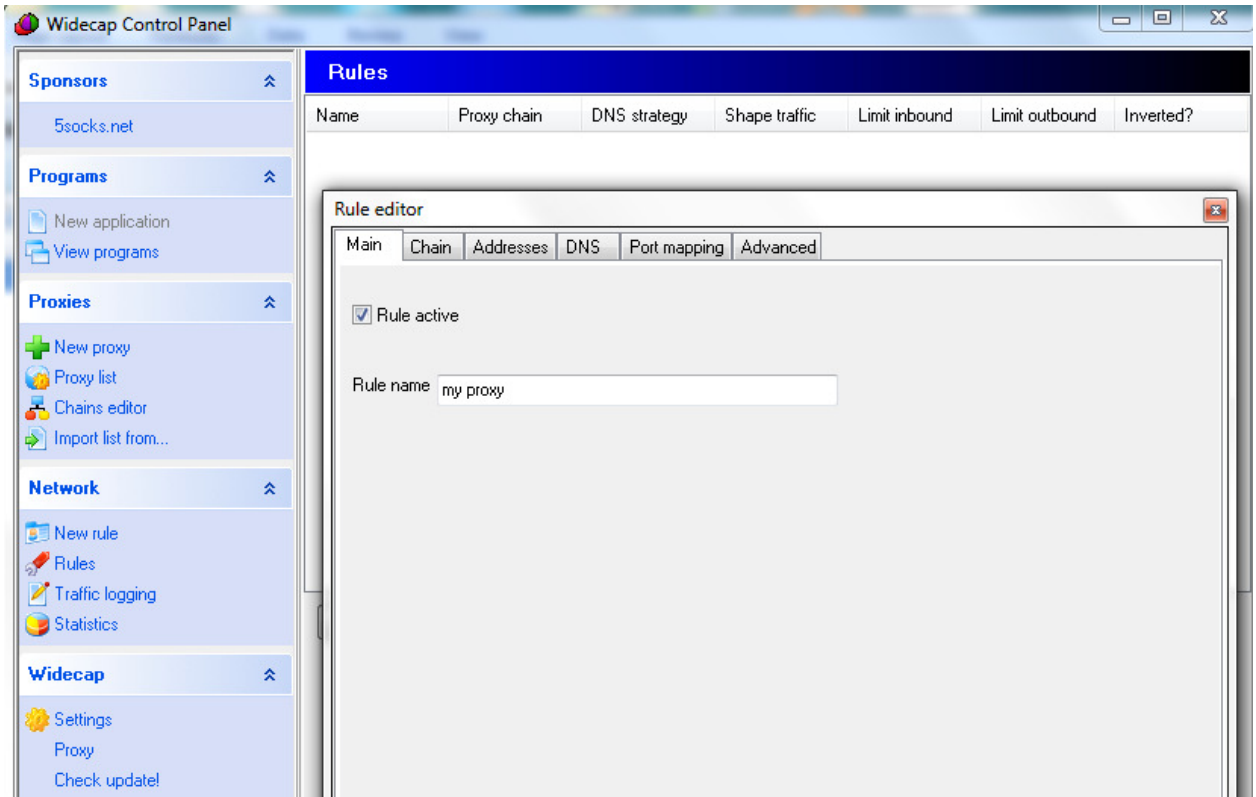
3. Click on "New Proxy" under Proxies on left column.

*Enter Server:Port in textbox.*

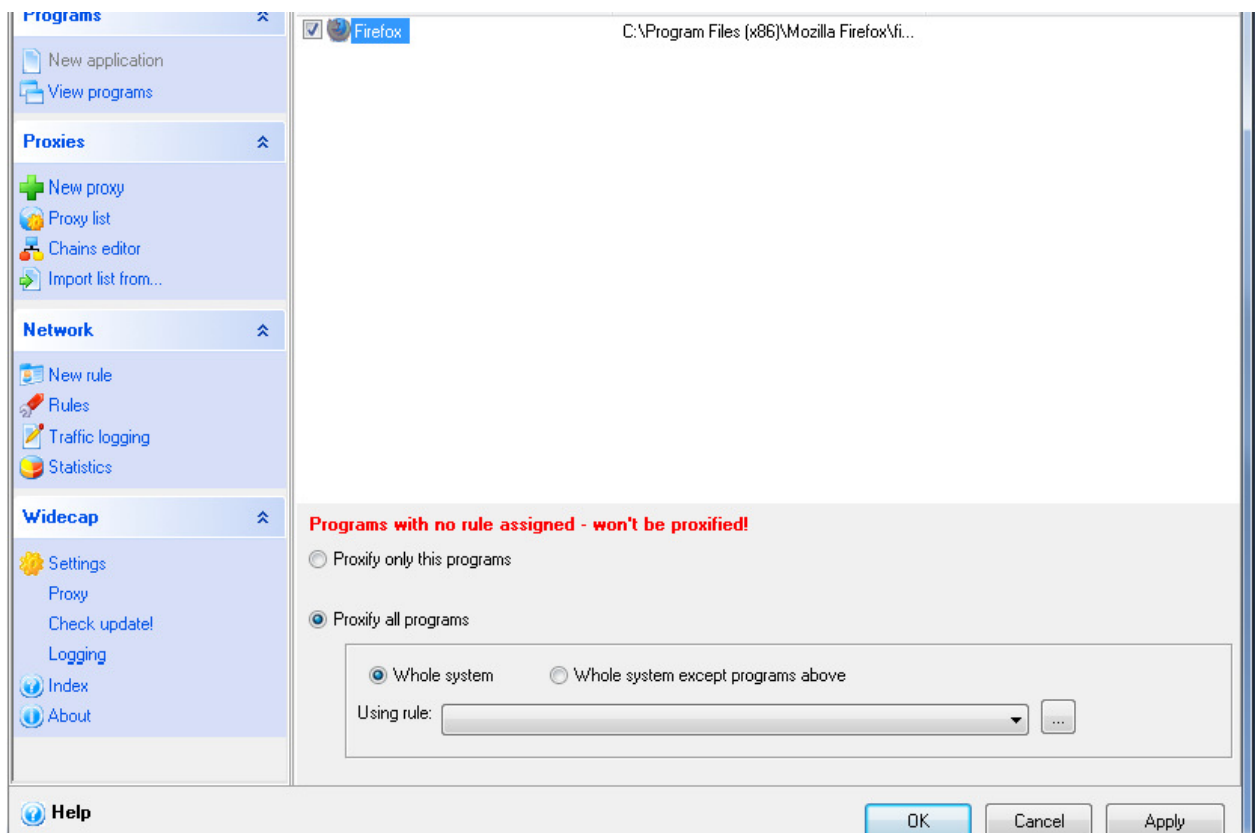
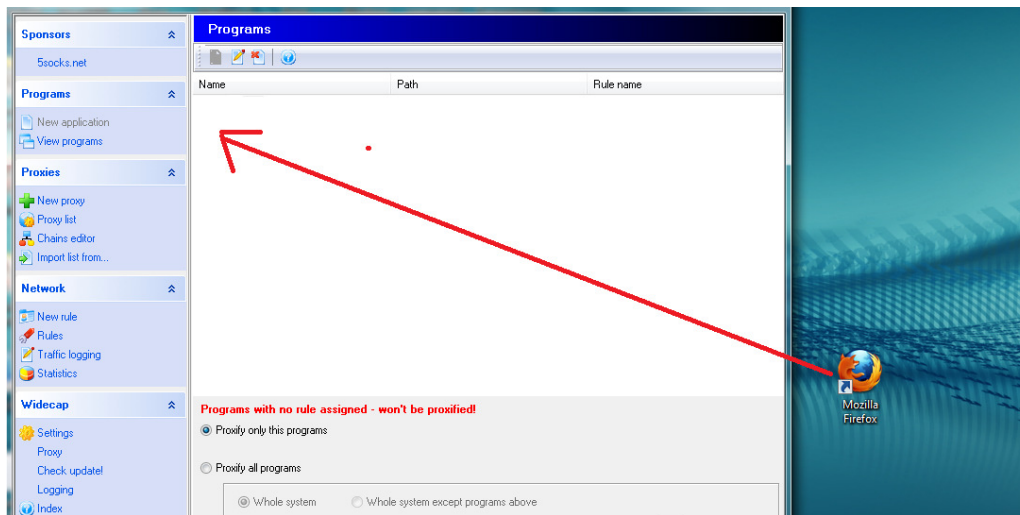
*Select "Socks v5" and tick "Authentication required". Then enter your username and password and finally click OK to save the proxy.*



4. Then go to "New Rule" under Network. Then under Main, enter the rule name such as "my proxy". Then go to the "Chain tab" and select "Unused" for the Proxy chain to be used. Then finally click OK. You can leave the rest as default.



5. Click on the "View Programs" menu under the Programs. Hold down on left Mouse button on that Firefox shortcut icon, then drag it into the the "Programs" Window.

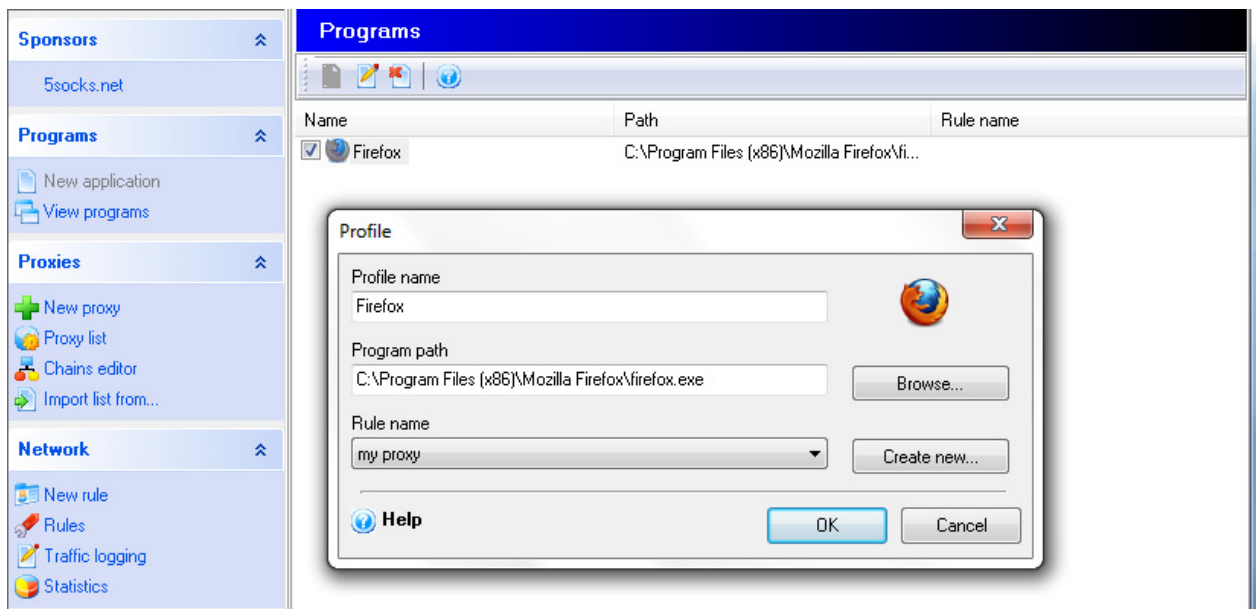


6. Double click on the Firefox icon and you will be presented a window as follows: Click "Firefox" to highlight-select it.

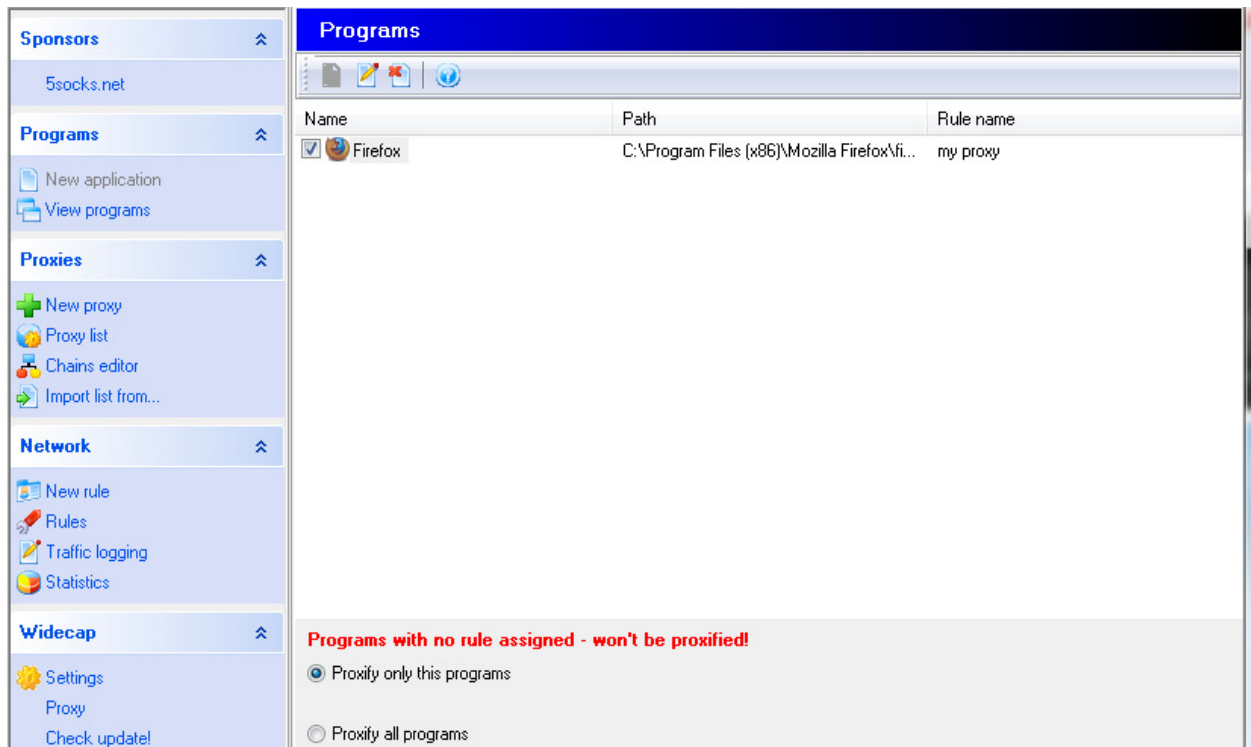
- Click "Edit" icon/button under "Programs" title bar

- Under "Rule name", select "My proxy", then click OK button.

- Click OK button (under "Programs" screen), which will minimize the WinCap application to taskbar as shown below.



7. Then select " Proxify only this programs" to activate it and click on Apply then OK.



8. *Open Firefox browser, then go to <http://www.myiptest.com> web site, which will display your "proxy server" IP information.*
